**1.1 Introduction**

Lisie College of Pharmacy is one of the premiere subsidiary units of Lisie Medical and Educational Institutions, Lisie Hospital Campus, Ernakulam, Kochi-18, a registered charitable trust (Reg. No. 334/IV/2001), owned and managed by the Archdiocese of Ernakulam-Angamaly.

Govt. of Kerala has granted Minority status to Lisie College of Pharmacy under Section 12 (B) of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions Act, 2004.

This prospectus relates to admission to B.Pharm course in Lisie College of Pharmacy, Lisie Medical and Educational Institutions, Vennala Campus, Vennala High School Road, Ernakulam, Kochi-682028. This prospectus sets out the rules and regulations for selection and admission to B. Pharm course for the academic year 2022-23 in Lisie College of Pharmacy. Selection of candidates will be purely on merit basis. The College has its own policies of reservations in admitting students.

### 2.2 Status of Affiliation/Approval of B.Pharm course for the academic year 2022-23

The four-year B.Pharm course conducted at Lisie College of Pharmacy is approved by the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) and All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE). Lisie College of Pharmacy is provisionally affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), Thrissur.

### 2.3 Details of seats

Details of allotment procedure and conditions to be fulfilled by a candidate to apply under General merit seats and Community merit seats are as follows.

#### 2.3.1 General Merit

All the applicants are eligible to be considered under General merit.

#### 2.3.2 Community Merit Quota

Candidates belonging to all Christian denominations are eligible to be considered in the community merit seats. Community certificate

issued by Revenue authorities of Govt. of Kerala/Govt.of India should be produced to prove the claim. Unfilled seats in this category will be reverted to General merit.

### 3. Eligibility for Admission

**3.1** Citizenship: Candidates must be citizens of India

**3.2.** Academic Qualification: Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala or examinations recognized as equivalent thereto **with 50% marks in Biology/Mathematics in the second year of the qualifying examination and an aggregate of 70 % marks in Physics and Chemistry in the second year of qualifying examination are only eligible.** Candidates who have passed their qualifying examinations from the states other than Kerala should produce the certificate of recognition and equivalence of qualifying examination.

### 3.3 Age

The applicant should have completed 17 years of age as on 31.12.2022. There is no upper age limit for B.Pharm course. However, the upper age limit for admission to B.Pharm course will be subject to the changes if any made by PCI/AICTE/KUHS.

### 4. 1. Procedure for obtaining Prospectus and submission of online application

For obtaining prospectus and submission of online application form candidate has to register with their preliminary information by

After completion of registration, candidate’s login credentials (User name and Password) will be send to candidate’s Registered E. mail ID and mobile number. A copy of Prospectus of B.Pharm Course 2022-23 (in pdf format) also will be send to registered E.mail ID and the applicants can download the attached prospectus from the same.

### 5. Preparation of Rank List

Rank list for Admission to B.Pharm Course is prepared on the basis of merit obtained in the Paper-I (Physics and Chemistry) of KEAM 2022. The index marks calculated for ranking shall be considered for the preparation of merit list. In case of a tie in the index marks computed for the preparation of B.Pharm rank list, the candidate with the higher marks in Chemistry in Paper-I of KEAM-2022 will be placed higher in the ranking. If there is still a tie, the candidate with the higher marks in Physics in Paper-I of KEAM-2022 will be placed higher in the ranking. Again if there is a tie, the age of the candidate will be taken into account and the older candidate will be placed higher in the ranking.

In case sufficient candidates with KEAM-2022 qualification have not applied, then candidates will be selected on merit calculated on the basis of marks obtained in Physics and Chemistry in the Second year of the qualifying examination. If there is a tie, marks obtained in Chemistry will be considered, if there is still a tie, marks obtained in English will be considered, if there is still a tie, the candidate with higher age on the date of counseling will be considered.
