1.Introduction

Lisie College of Pharmacy is one of the premiere subsidiary units of Lisie Medical and Educational Institutions, Lisie Hospital Campus, Ernakulam, Kochi-18, a registered Charitable trust (Reg. No. 334/IV/2001), owned and managed by the Archdiocese of Ernakulam-Angamaly. Lisie College of Pharmacy is a “Minority Educational Institution” under Section 12 (B) of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions Act, 2004(G.O.(Rt)No.5382/2021/GEDN dated 24-11-2021).

This prospectus sets out the rules and regulations for selection and admission to the B.Pharm course for the academic year 2026-27 in Lisie College of Pharmacy. Selection of candidates will be purely on merit basis. The College has its own policies of reservations in admitting students.

This prospectus is subject to modification/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the said Institution and also subject to further orders, if any, passed by courts of law.

This prospectus is provisionally approved by the Admission Supervisory Committee (ASC) for Medical Education in Kerala (Order No ASC100/26/PHARMACY/LCP dated 21/08/2026).

3. Status of Affiliation/Approval of B.Pharm course

The four-year B.Pharm course conducted in Lisie College of Pharmacy is provisionally affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), Thrissur, Kerala and is approved by Pharmacy Council of India (PCI).

4. Details of seats

Govt. merit seats are filled up by the Controller of Entrance Examinations (CEE), Govt. of Kerala.

Management seats are filled up by the college. Details of the allotment procedure and conditions to be fulfilled by a candidate to apply under Management seats (General merit seats and Christian Community merit seats) are as follows.

4.1 General Merit

All the applicants are eligible to be considered under General merit.

4.2 Community Merit Quota

Candidates belonging to any Christian denomination are eligible to be considered in the community merit seats. Community certificate issued by Revenue authorities of Govt. of Kerala/Govt. of India should be produced to prove the claim. Unfilled seats in this category will be reverted to General merit.

5. Eligibility for Admission

5.1 Citizenship: Candidates must be citizens of India

5.2 Academic Qualification: Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala, or examinations recognized as equivalent thereto **with 50% marks in Biology/Mathematics in the second year of the qualifying examination and an aggregate of 60 % marks in Physics and Chemistry in the second year of the qualifying examination are only eligible.** Candidates who have passed their qualifying examinations from states other than Kerala should produce the certificate of recognition and equivalence of qualifying examination.

5.3 Age

The applicant should have completed 17 years of age as on 31.12.2026. There is no upper age limit for B.Pharm course. However, the upper age limit for admission to B.Pharm course will be subject to changes if any, made by PCI/KUHS.

6. Procedure for obtaining Prospectus and submission of online application

For obtaining the prospectus and submission of online application form, the candidate has to register their preliminary details on the online web-portal of the college - www.lcop.edu.in.

6.1 Registration of the candidate

Click on the “Apply online” tab provided on the website www.lcop.edu.in. Registration of the candidate can be done by entering the preliminary details such as the name of the applicant, Contact details etc.

Please note that for registration, candidates should have a valid E. mail ID and a valid mobile number.

After completion of registration, candidate’s login credentials (User name and Password) will be sent to candidate’s registered E. mail ID and mobile number.

A copy of Prospectus of B.Pharm Course 2026-27 (in pdf format) also will be sent to registered E.mail ID and the applicants can download the attached prospectus from the same.

Read the prospectus carefully before filling the online application.

6.2 Submission of Online Application Form

6.2.9 Preview & Edit

6.2.10 Final Submission of application

Candidates can submit the duly filled online application by clicking “**Submit application**” in the online application window. After submission of the online application, an acknowledgement and a copy of the application form submitted (in pdf. format) will be sent to the candidate’s registered E.mail ID.

Candidates should take a printout of the submitted application form. Facility for taking out the “printout of application form submitted” is also provided in the College office.

7. Preparation of Rank List

7.1 The selection of candidates to all seats shall be purely on inter-se merit, based on normalized score (out of 300) obtained in KEAM-2026(Pharmacy). A candidate who has scored a minimum normalized score of 10 out of the index of 300 shall only be considered as KEAM 2026 (Pharmacy) qualified for the preparation of this rank list. In case of a tie in the normalized score of the candidates, the age of the candidate will be taken into account and the older candidate will be placed higher in the ranking. In case sufficient candidates with KEAM-2026 (Pharmacy) qualification have not applied/joined, then applications from candidates without KEAM-2026 (Pharmacy) score shall be considered for admission. Selection of such candidates will be based on a rank list prepared on the basis of marks obtained in Chemistry and Physics, in the second year of the qualifying examinations conducted by the various boards or authorities after effecting normalization in each subject. A weightage in a ratio of 3:2 shall be given to Chemistry: Physics in the preparation of the rank list. If there is a tie in the

index mark, then the candidate with a higher percentage of marks in chemistry shall get the higher rank. In case there is still a tie in the index mark the percentage of marks obtained in English shall be considered for higher ranking. In case there is again a tie, the candidate with higher age will be considered for ranking.

7.2 Provisional Rank List will be published on the College website (www.lcop.edu.in)/College Notice Board. Applicants shall verify their application details, including marks, and in case of any discrepancies, it may be intimated to the College office by email (admissions@lcp.edu.in) on the same day (before 12.00 pm) of publication of the Provisional Rank List. Final Rank lists will be published on the date and time stipulated for the same in **Clause 8**.

9. Procedure of Admission

9.1. Counselling and admission

Admission of candidates to 15 general merit seats will be conducted in the order of their rank in the rank list. Allotment to the remaining 15 seats under Christian minority quota will be conducted for the candidates belonging to the Christian community in the order of rank in the rank list. Unfilled seats if any, in the Christian community quota will be reverted to general merit seats.

Selected candidates shall take admission at the appointed time and date in the College after paying the Tuition fee, Caution Deposit and Special fee etc. as mentioned in **clause 11**, failing which, the offer of admission will be cancelled. Fees can be paid online through the link given on our website www.lcop.edu.in or through Cheque/DD/RTGS/IMPS. “In the case of SC/ST candidates, their liability to pay fees shall be governed by the orders issued from time to time issued by the central and the state governments and those of the SC/ST Departments. No fee will be collected from SC/ST students or other eligible candidates except in accordance with the orders of the Central or the State Government.”

8. Minority Certificate from Revenue Officer (Village officer/Tahsildar), if admitted under Christian community seats

12. Discontinuation of course and payment of liquidated damages

“Candidates who express their intention to discontinue their studies in the pharmacy college by giving due intimation before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the first year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. Students who discontinue the course will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the college at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the college midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent civil court. Claim by the management for liquidated damages against the student will not be a ground to withhold the original certificates of the student”.

13. Code of Conduct

Every student is required to adhere strictly to the code of conduct of the Institution.

14. Caution: Prohibition of Ragging

Ragging/ any type of misconduct towards any student, either in the College campus or outside, will be considered a criminal offence and will be immediately reported to the police. Perpetrators will not be permitted to continue their studies. Every student shall, at the time of admission, furnish a conduct certificate from the Institute from which he/she has passed the qualifying examination/the course last attended.
