**PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO
B.PHARM (LATERAL ENTRY) COURSE 2026-27**

1.1 Introduction

Lisie College of Pharmacy is one of the premiere subsidiary units of Lisie Medical and Educational Institutions, Lisie Hospital Campus, Ernakulam, Kochi-18, a registered Charitable trust (Reg. No. 334/IV/2001), owned and managed by the Archdiocese of Ernakulam-Angamaly. Lisie College of Pharmacy is a “Minority Educational Institution” under Section 12 (B) of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions Act, 2004 (G.O.(Rt)No.5382/2021/GEDN dated 24-11-2021).

This prospectus sets out the rules and regulations for selection and admission to B.Pharm (LE) course for the academic year 2026-27 in Lisie College of Pharmacy. Selection of candidates will be purely on merit basis. The College has its own policies of reservations in admitting students.

This prospectus is subject to modification/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the said Institution and also subject to further orders if any passed by courts of law.



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This prospectus is provisionally approved by the Admission Supervisory Committee (ASC) for Medical Education in Kerala (Order No.ASC100/26/PHARMACY/LCP dated 21/08/2026).

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3. Status of Affiliation/Approval of B.Pharm (LE) course

B.Pharm (LE) course conducted at Lisie College of Pharmacy is approved by the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI). Lisie College of Pharmacy is provisionally affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), Thrissur.

4.1 Management seats

Details of allotment procedure and conditions to be fulfilled by a candidate to apply under Management seats are as follows.

All the applicants are eligible to be considered under General merit under Management seats. 06 seats under the Management seat shall be allotted to candidates belonging to Christian community. Candidates belonging to any Christian denomination are eligible to be considered in the community merit seat. Minority certificate issued by Revenue authorities of Govt. of Kerala/Govt. of India should be



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produced to prove the claim. Unfilled seats in this category will be reverted to General merit.

4.2 Government Merit Quota

Government Merit Quota (03) seats are filled up by the Controller of Entrance Examiner (CEE), Government of Kerala. If CEE has not allotted candidate to the 03 government seats of B.Pharm (LE) in Government Quota; it will be filled up by the College as Management seats and students will be admitted accordingly.

5. Eligibility for Admission

5.1 Citizenship: Candidates must be citizens of India

5.2. Academic Qualification: Candidates who have passed Diploma in Pharmacy (D.Pharm) examination conducted by the Board of D.Pharm Examinations, Directorate of Medical Education, Government of Kerala or other recognized Examination authority/board with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks for the D. Pharm Part I and D Pharm Part II Examinations put together.

5.3 Registration as a Pharmacist: Candidates should be registered with State Pharmacy Council or should have applied for registration with Pharmacy Council and the proof thereof is to be produced at the time of counseling.

5.4 Age

There is no upper age limit for B.Pharm (LE) course.

6. Procedure for obtaining Prospectus and submission of online application



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For obtaining prospectus and submission of online application form candidate has to register their preliminary details on the online web-portal of the college - www.lcop.edu.in .

6.1 Registration of the candidate

Click on the “Apply online” tab provided on the website. Registration of the candidate can be done entering the preliminary details such as Name of the applicant, Contact details etc.

Please note that for registration, candidates should have a valid E. mail ID and a valid mobile number.

After completion of registration, candidate's login credentials (User name and Password) will be sent to candidate's registered E. mail ID and mobile number.

A copy of Prospectus of B.Pharm (LE) Course 2026-27 (in pdf format) also will be sent to registered E.mail ID, and the applicants can download the attached prospectus from the same.

Read the prospectus carefully before filling the online application.

6.2 Submission of Online Application Form

Login to online application by clicking on “Apply online” tab provided on the website www.lcop.edu.in. Then enter the candidate's Login credentials (User name and Password).

6.2.1 Payment of Application Fee

Make payment of application fee (**Rs.500/-**) through the online payment window.

Upload a passport size photograph (in jpg format, less than 2 mb size)

- Enter the details of Caste/Religion Certificate from Revenue Officer (village officer/ tahsildar)

6.2.7 Declaration by the Candidate and Parent/Guardian

If the candidate and parent agree with the statement given in the declaration section with respect to the application of the candidate for B.Pharm (LE) course in Lisie College of Pharmacy, tick the respective **Agree** columns given under declarations by candidate and parent/guardian. Upload the signatures (jpg format, 2 mb) of both candidate and parent/guardian.

6.2.8 Preview & Edit

Candidate can preview and edit the entries if required. Verify the details entered, if any changes are required, please go back by clicking on **Edit** and make correct entries.

6.2.9 Final Submission of application

Candidates can submit the duly filled online application by clicking “**Submit application**” in online application window. After submission of online application an acknowledgement and a copy of application form submitted (in pdf. format) will be sent to candidate’s registered E.mail ID.

Candidates are should take a printout of the submitted application form. Facility for taking out the “print of application form submitted” is also provided in the College office.

6.2.10 Submission of Print out of the application to college



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Applicant has to submit the following documents to the college either directly or by speed post/courier before the last date for the same mentioned in the prospectus.

7. Preparation of Rank List

Rank list for Admission to B.Pharm (LE) is prepared by adding Marks obtained in the first year and second year of D.Pharm Course. In case of a tie in the total marks, the candidate with the higher marks in second year D.Pharm will be placed higher in the ranking. If still there is a tie, candidate with higher age will be placed higher in the ranking. Provisional Rank List will be published on College website (www.lcop.edu.in) /notice board. Applicants shall verify their application details including marks and in case of any discrepancies, it may be intimated to the college office by E. Mail (admissions@lcp.edu.in) within the stipulated date and time. Please

9. Procedure of Admission

Selected candidates shall take admission at the appointed time and date in the College after paying the Tuition fee, Caution Deposit and Special fee etc. as mentioned in the **clause. 11**, failing which, the offer of admission will be cancelled.

1. SC/ST candidates will have to pay the normal fees. The fees will be refunded as and when the Government reimburses their fees to the College.
